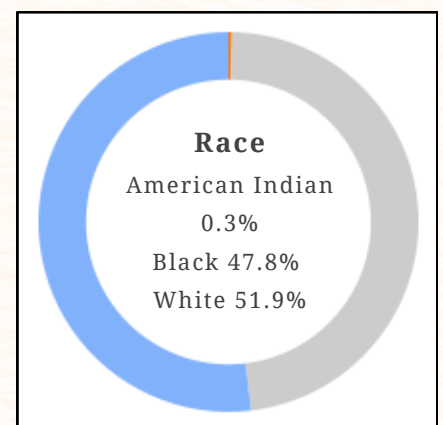
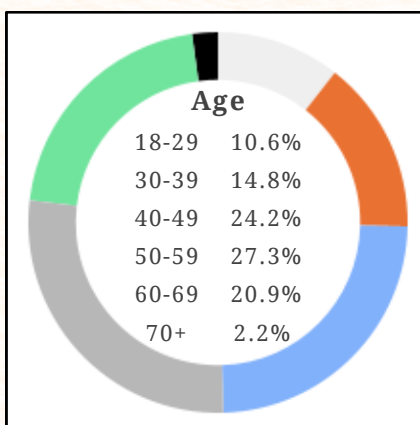
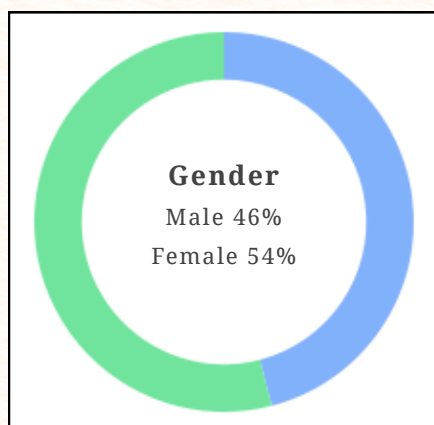
...And Why

99% of our patients come from Newton, Jasper, Walton, and Rockdale counties.

According to statistical data:

- 11.5% of our neighbors live below the Federal Poverty Level
- 39% of our neighbors live at or above the poverty level, but cannot afford the basic cost of living
- 13% cannot afford healthcare insurance
- 84% of our active patients are struggling with one or more chronic illness

Ministry Highlights

Partnered with Open Hand Atlanta and BD to provide medically-tailored meals delivered to our most dire diabetic patients. 1,372 meals were delivered, and participants' average A1c levels dropped from 9.9% to 8.2%.

Upgraded our Electronic Medical Records to Athena to provide a more comprehensive and efficient process for charting chronic illness care.

Due to an overwhelming demand for our services, appointment times were extending to 90 days for even simple lab work. We've added additional providers and staff and opened our schedule more to accommodate the growing need.

Through marketing efforts, both online and word of mouth, our awareness has grown so much that we had a 42% increase in new patients from the end of 2024.

Partnered with Georgia Baptist Mobile Health Ministry Foundation to provide a weekend of dental care, offering cleanings, fillings, and extractions for anyone without insurance.

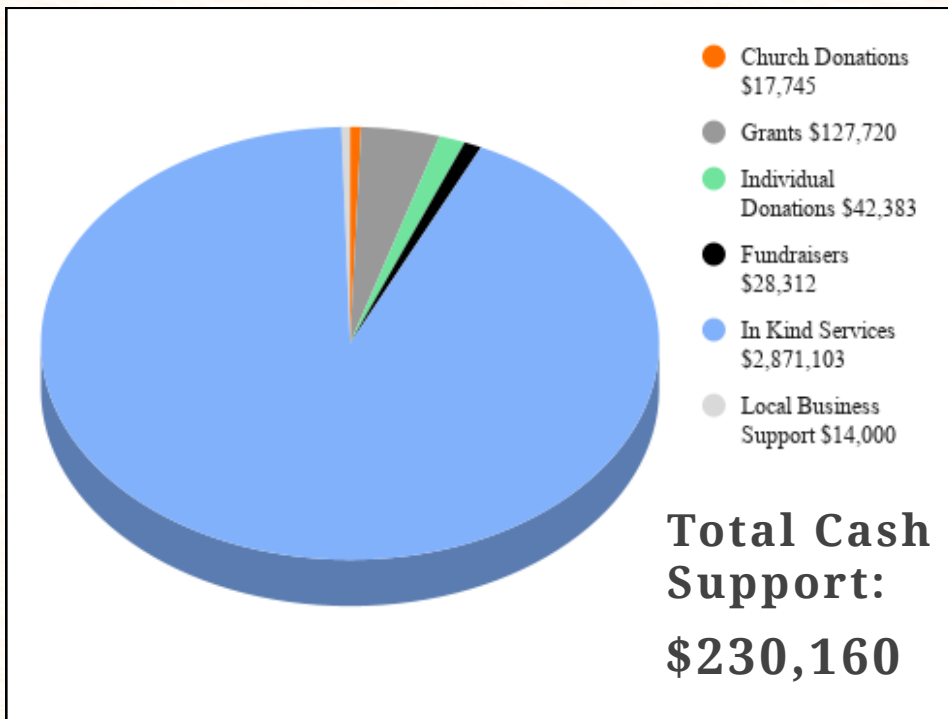

Patient Stories

Lenward had been managing his health without consistent access to care, often going without treatment because he could not afford it. Over time, his condition worsened, leaving him without a clear path forward.



At the clinic, Lenward received consistent care focused on stabilizing his health and improving long-term outcomes. Providers worked with him to monitor his condition, guide lifestyle changes, and provide ongoing support.

As a result, Lenward now has his diabetes under control without medication and is maintaining stable blood pressure. His progress reflects the impact of consistent care and guidance.



Andrew came to the clinic without insurance and had delayed care for too long, unsure how to manage his health. Without guidance, his condition remained difficult to control.

At the clinic, Andrew received both medical care and nutritional education to help him make sustainable lifestyle changes.

Providers monitored his condition and supported him through ongoing follow-up care.

Today, Andrew is keeping his A1C in check through lifestyle changes and maintaining stable blood pressure. His story demonstrates how education and consistent care can lead to lasting improvements.

Patricia faced ongoing health challenges while lacking access to consistent care and necessary medications. Without support, managing her condition was difficult and uncertain.



At the clinic, Patricia received the medications and follow-up care needed to manage her COPD. Providers worked closely with her to monitor her condition and ensure continuity of care.

With this support, Patricia is now able to better manage her condition and maintain greater stability in her health. Access to consistent care has made a meaningful difference in her quality of life.

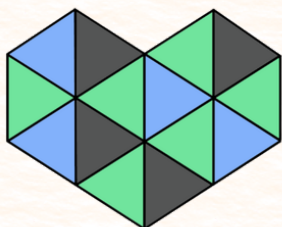

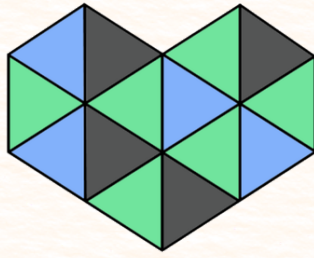
